WOMEN EMPOWERMENT

Dehradun

Women in the rural settings are overloaded with the heterogeneous nature of responsibilities, viz; family & child care, agriculture, livestock care & management and social & religious obligations. Accordingly they need variety of know-how options of ideas / tools / techniques to cope with the circumstances they live in. Watershed management programmes based on people's participation, provide ample opportunity for the rural women to interact with the experts from different subject areas in village itself and that too at least for 5 years of project period. These programmes have been proved to be boon for those interested to upgrade their exposure and skill levels specially in the fields of agriculture, livestock and natural resource management.

Alongwith dissemination of knowledge and skill through outreach programmes, CSWCRTI, Dehradun is also organizing short course

campus trainings in natural resource management where rural women are encouraged for more and more participation so that they could be enabled to address the problem of hunger and malnutrition in the country. According to global hunger Index 2010 by IFPRI, India is among 29 countries with highest level of hunger, stunted children and poorly fed women.

At CSWCRTI, Dehradun during the year 2011-12, 26 on-campus training programmes sponsored by different central and state level agencies were organized. Women participation was witnessed in 9 training programmes (Photo 44). Duration of training programmes varied from 3 days to 5½ months and a total 41 women trained at Dehradun as below:
