1. The sub-division comprising of Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram and Tripura (NMMT), Konkan-Goa, Coastal Karnataka, Marathwada, Telangana, South interior Karnataka and Kerala received widespread rainfall yesterday.
2. Southwest monsoon has further advanced into some more parts of Madhya Maharashtra, North Interior Karnataka, coastal Andhra Pradesh and entire South Interior Karnataka.
3. The rainfall status of all the meteorological subdivisions of the country is normal or excess due to monsoon/premonsoon rainfall except in east UP, Jharkhand, West Bengal-Sikkim and Assam -Meghalaya.
