An experiment on availability of moisture under dry farming conditions in relation to time of plantation/sowing indicated that the crop (tobacco) planted in early stages of rainfall provides better utilization of moisture and its availability during the crop growth. Law planting showed that there was deficit of moisture in the effective root zone at later stage of crop growth.
