In a diagnostic survey to have the appraisal of existing farming systems and agrofores practices under Mussoorie hills, 120 farm families from 9 villages representing different land holdings were covered. People were found interested to integrate fruit trees agricultural crops and some MPT like Grewia optiva with crops on terrace risers. Farmer were also found to have great interest for cash crops like ginger, turmeric, potato, tomas chillies and integration of the same with trees in homesteads. Under management studies the influence of boundary row trees, planting direction, trenching, mulching, manufacture, manuf and intercropping of field crops with fodder crop of Leucaena leucocephala were stated under rainfed conditions.
