Major crops were studied under intercropping and double cropping systems from 1976 to 1982 at Kota (Rajasthan). It was indicated that cultivation of pigeonpea + blackgram, pigeonpea + sorghum and pigeonpea + greengram intercropping in 1:1 in general, castor + sesame (1:2) under severe drought and greengram-safflower and greengram-taramira double cropping under normal rains and favourable moisture, production can be increased and stabilised under rainfed agriculture.
