

701. **Mathur, H.N. and Joshie, P. 1976.** Napier grass for Doon Valley. *Indian Fmg.*, 27(5): 23-25.

The paper discusses the method of propagation and management of napier and hybrid grasses in Doon Valley and adjoining hills. Napier grass yielded about 300 to 350 q/ha of green fodder/cut on an annual basis which at Rs. 2/- can fetch an annual income of Rs. 600 to 700/ha depending upon the proximity of the planting site to the market. Napier and hybrid napier grasses are excellent raw materials for stabilizing the land slides, reclaimed torrent beds, eroded land and gullied lands.
