The paper highlights the role of river depth, meandering, confluence, pot holes, cracks and the catchment in the ravines along the river Chambal and its tributaries flowing in almost flat alluvial plains having high percentage of clay that has low dispersion coefficient. Separate identities have been attributed to ravines and gullies.
