The authors call for adopting proper soil and water conservation measures to reclaim the ravine lands in Gujarat so as to save them from further degradation. As a measure, vegetative cover has been given more emphasis. At Vasad, there was an increase in the income from grasses by about ninefold from Rs. 159.12 in 1956-57 to Rs. 1373.12 in 1959-60 simply due to closure from biotic interference implying that vegetative cover while saving the soil from erosion also provides income from the produce.
