Suggestions for increasing cropping intensity and new introductions have been made, from an 8 ha agricultural watershed and ponded in a 0.6 ha m field pond facilitated stabilizing double cropping system. Graded and marginal bunds as mechanical measures of soil conservation, contour cultivation, mix cropping, double cropping as biological measures of crop production and water harvesting and utilization for application to rabi crops is proposed as a useful package for increasing crop production in rainfed agricultural areas of south-eastern Rajasthan.
