
MAJOR EVENTS

A White Burley Research Station at Chintapalli (Vizag District, Andhra Pradesh) was opened on 8th April, 1983, in an area of 12 acres of land provided by the Assistant Director, Animal Husbandry, ITDA. Government Live Stock Farm, Chintapalli. A time bound programme was chalked out and nursery raising was taken-up immediately to supply seedlings for about 50 acres (50 tribal farmers) besides meeting Institute's experimental requirements.

This Institute did commendable research work at Devarapalli, Kovvur Taluk, West Godavari District and thereby bringing a vast area of Northern Light Soils for FCV tobacco cultivation by the poor and marginal farmers. The NLS tobacco is having good demand in the International market and is of excellent quality. To meet the demand of competitive price in the International market and boost the foreign exchange to the National exchequer, it is imperative on the part of this Research Institute to improve the qualitative and quantitative production of FCV tobacco grown in the Northern Light Soils. Inauguration of White Burley Research Station, Chintapalli by Sri S.V. Prasad, IAS, District Collector, Vizag.





this important task this Institute has opened a permanent NLS Research Station at Kalavacherla near Rajanagaram (East Godavari District) on 18th April, 1983 in an area of 22.08 acres to conduct research activities on various

types of tobacco, thereby expanding the dry farming area into tobacco cultivation. It is also long felt need and strong desire of the NLS farmers of this District.

RESEARCH HIGHLIGHTS

CTRI Rajahmundry:

Crop rotation studies in black soils have shown that blackgram in kharif followed by FCV tobacco in rabi, fertilized at 30 kg N/ha, recorded the highest cured leaf yield and maximum monetary returns, compared with greengram or fallow in kharif.

Incorporation of TMV resistance into variety Jayasri has been completed and designated as Jayasri MR, it produced 2100 kgs of cured leaf and 1007 kgs of TBLE per ha. Selection D1 obtained through pollen culture produced 1950 kgs of cured leaf and 1180 kgs of TBLE.

In the programme on Tissue Culture studies, a number of interspecific hybrids are being studied for in vitro fer-

tilization. Regeneration of disease free plants through meristem tip culture has been taken up and results are encouraging.

It was conclusively proved that an intergrated schedule of 3 sprays of NSKS at 2% and periodical releases of two natural enemies viz. *Telenomus remus* and *Chrysopa scelestes* is highly effective in controlling *Spodoptera litura* F. during the entire nursery period and the use of poisonous chemicals can be dispensed with.

Among the new fungicides evaluated for the control of soil borne pathogens viz. *Pythium aphanidermatum* and *Phytophthora parasitica* causing damping off and black shank, two sprays of Ridomil 25 WP @ 0.5%, 0.1% and 0.2%, three sprays of Difoltan 80 WP@ 0.2%, M. 9834 EC. 0.1% + Dithan Z. 78 0.1%, Rallis Capter F 75

WP 0.2%, M. 9834 EC 0.1% + Fytolan 0.1% and Lesan (Bayer 5072) @ 0.05% were found highly effective.

Commercial nicotine was successfully converted to nictinamide through nicotinic acid and ethyl nicotinate. However, the yield of the final product needs to be improved for economic viability of the process.

CTRI Research Station, Guntur:

Studies on the effect of organic and inorganic manurial combinations in different proportions on the yield and quality of FCV tobacco has revealed that the application of FYM @ 2.5 tonnes/ha in combination with 20 kg N/ha as ammonium sulphate has improved the yields of FCV tobacco without any adverse affect on the quality leaf production followed by the treatment, application of 30 kg N/ha as ammonium sulphate alone.

CTRI Research Station, Kandukur:

In nursery beds Blitox 0.2% or Bordeaux mixture 0.4% were found effective in controlling damping-off and hence recommended.

CTRI Research Station, Vedasandur:

A special project under the auspices of Joint Director of Agriculture, Coimbatore was taken-up to demonstrate the use of neem oil emulsion for suppression of suckers on chewing tobacco, during the year 1982-83 in 50 acre blocks in each of the areas viz., Mettupalayam, Karamadí, Sirumugori and Dhayamur.

Out of 490 acres under chewing tobacco, 255 acres were covered under this programme. It was demonstrated that sucker control with neem oil emulsion not only compared favourably with hand suckering but also increased the yields by 80 to 100 kg per acre resulting in an increased income of Rs. 240/- to 300/- per acre.

CTRI Research Station, Hunsur:

A new fumigant (MB-EDB in 1:1 mixture) was tested and found to give absolute protection against root-knot nematodes and controlled nutgrass and other weeds effectively and reduced soil—borne pathogenic infections. Treated seedlings had profuse root system and established well in field.

CTRI Research Station, Pusa:

At 50 kg level of P_2O_5/ha , Mussooriephos with Aspergillus culture was a cheaper—source of P_2O_5 , but equally effective to triple super phosphate on the yield of chewing tobacco in sandy loam calcareous soils of North Bihar.

CTRI Research Station, Dinhata:

Studies on the effect of N, P and K on the yield and quality of Motihari tobacco showed that highest yield of 3034 kg/ha was obtained with 120 kg N/ha, 50 kg P₂O₈/ha and 100 kg K₂O/ha.

Lab-to-Land Programme:

CTRI Rajahmundry:


Fifty tribal farming families from Vattigadda of East Godavari District were classified under different categories viz., crop enterprise. commercial nursery management and landless labourers.

Ten Girijan Mahilas raised White Burley tobacco nursery in an extent of 1.25 acres and they were supplied critical inputs like seeds, fertilizers and pesticides.

Of the thirty farming families in crop enterprise, twelve families were given TMV 2 groundnut seed and fertilizers and the remaining eighteen families were supplied with gingelly. The ten landless farm families were distributed crowbars, iron pans, goats, etc.
