## RESEARCH HIGHLIGHTS

- □ At CTRI Research Station, Vedasandur two caterpillar resistant selections of sun cured and sun-cum-smoke cured chewing tobacco viz., HV 2000-2 and HV 2000-6, developed through back cross method of breeding showed stable resistance and higher productivity of 3608 and 3735 kg/ha of total cured leaf respectively than to check HV 86-2 and Abirami.
- □ Among 40 F<sub>1</sub> hybrids, F<sub>1.9</sub> has been identified as the most promising in terms of high productivity (4222 kg/ha of total leaf and 3539 kg/ha of whole leaf) and significantly high standard heterosis (9.58% and 19.0%) over chewing tobacco variety, Abirami.
- □ 'Sunflower tobacco' cropping sequence recorded the highest net return of Rs.62,702/ha. The B: C ratio (2.46) was higher with sole crop of chewing tobacco.
- □ Among the advanced chewing tobacco breeding lines tested in Vedaranyam area, HV 96-3 recorded numerically higher cured leaf yield of 3185 kg/ha with plant spacing of 80 x 90 cm and 150 kg N/ha.
- ☐ At CTRI Research Station, Hunsur, castor was found to be the most profitable followed by finger millet as a rotation crop with Kharif FCV tobacco.

## **IDENTIFICATION OF NEW VARIETIES**

The Tobacco Variety Release / Identification Committee meeting was held at the Institute on 10<sup>th</sup> June 2004. Dr. K. C. Jain, ADG (CC), Dr. A. Satyanarayana, Director of Extension, ANGRAU; Director, CTRI and members from Tobacco Board, Trade and Industry attended the meeting. Two FCV tobacco varieties viz., "Hemadri"

(II-1624) for Central and Southern black cotton soils of Andhra Pradesh and "Kanthi" (Cy-79) for Southern light soils and Southern black soils of Andhra Pradesh; one Natu tobacco variety "Bhairavi" (NG-73) for rainfed areas and one burley tobacco variety "Sweta" (BSRB-2) for agency areas of Andhra Pradesh, were identified.

# Database Management System for Income Generation Training Programmes

A computer software was developed for facilitating access of detailed information on various training programmes conducted like number of trainees undergone in each training programme, toolkits received, monthly income earned, bank loans/financial assistance taken, marketing of products, practicing skills developed, capital investment made. The information can be obtained either year wise or

trade wise which will be useful for the scientists in formulating new training programmes or to search for the information on a particular training programme. This software is flexible and provides on-line access of the information on required parameters. The user can take hard copies of the stored information and update the information on new training programmes from time to time.
