From the Director's Desk

Unprecedented heavy rains during 1st fortnight of October, 2nd fortnight of November and 1st fortnight of December have caused severe damage to the transplanted Virginia tobacco in Coastal Andhra leading the water-logging and damage to the tobacco crop in East Godavari, West Godavari, Khammam, Guntur, Krishna, Prakasam and Nellore districts. The farmers had to invest lot of money for repeated transplanting (2-3 times) incurring heavy expenditure.



Crop damage in Black soils due to heavy rains Following the rains, diseases like black shank, brown spot and other leaf spot diseases have caused further damage to the crop. Other tobacco types viz., Burley, Lanka, Natu, HDBRG and Bidi are also affected due to heavy rains. Growers started draining over the excess water and carryingout cultural operations like opening the plough furrow etc. to save the crop and to boost the crop growth.

In Andhra Pradesh, marketing of 2009-10 FCV crop was completed. As

against the authorized quantity of 170.2 M kg, 206.8 M kg was produced and sold in the Tobacco Board Auction Platforms at an average price of ₹ 80.23 having a total economic value of ₹ 1658 crores. However, a decline ranging from ₹ 35/- to 40/- was observed in the average price per kg in different zones.

In Karnataka, as against the fixed crop size of 100 M kg, 51.05 M kg has been marketed at an average price of ₹ 93.76 per kg till 31.12.2010. It is expected that KLS farmers would get better prices for 2010 crop.

RESEARCH HIGHLIGHTS

- § In KLS, pod borer, Helicoverpa armigera incidence was found to be more in field bean, pigeonpea and cowpea crops in tobacco based cropping system, while caterpillar, Spodoptera litura and Aphid, Aphis croccivora were below ET level (<5%).
- **₽** Root knot nematode, Meloidogyne spp., and reniform nematode. Rotulenchulus reniformis were found to be associated with FCV tobacco in all tobacco growing areas of Mysore district. A mild population of Pratylenchus spp. was also found in Hunsur and Periyapatna taluks.
