District Level Exhibition and Farmers' Fair at CAZRI, Jodhpur

A district level exhibition and farmers' fair was held on 28th January 2019 at the ICAR-Central Arid Zone Research Institute which was organized jointly by Krishi Vigyan Kendra and Agricultural Technology Management Agency (ATMA).
