Farmer FIRST Programme under ATARI, Jabalpur

Farmer FIRST project is operational at seven centres under ATARI Jabalpur. During April-June, 2019 following progress was made as under the crop based module total 25 villages, 438.47 ha area and 1091 households covered, under horticulture based module total 24 villages, 29.93 ha area and 1328 households covered, under Livestock based module total 24 villages, 3071 animals (2620 Livestock and poultry, 209 goats, 220 ducks and 22 kg fish

fingerlings) and 327 households and 15 SHGs covered, under enterprise based module total 22 villages and 159 households covered, under integrated farming system Module, 12 villages and 63 households covered, under natural resource management, 21 villages, 186 ha area and 599 households covered, under ICT based module, 20 villages covered, 56 messages delivered, 524 telephonic calls and 1403 household covered.





Technology Demonstration Component under NICRA by KVKs NICRA is operational in 12 KVKs of Zone IX.

- ▶ Under Natural Resources Management Module, a total of 738 farmers benefited with covering area 506.01 ha in all activities were conducted focusing on *in-situ* moisture conservation, soil test based nutrient application and pitcher irrigation, vermicompost making summer deep ploughing etc.
- ▶ Under Crop Production Module, a total of 432 farmers benefited with covered 223.70 ha area focused on drought tolerant varieties, short duration varieties, crop diversification, integrated crop management etc. on soybean, maize, blackgram and vegetable crops.
- Under Livestock and Fisheries Module, a total of 778 farmers benefited through covering 1246

- animals and birds focusing the preventive vaccination, de-worming of animals and animal health camp and 5.00 ha area were covered.
- ▶ Under Institutional interventions, in custom hiring through various implements-rotavator, multi crop thresher and seed drill, etc. 288 farmers were benefitted with covered 146 ha, area.
- Under Capacity Building, total 33 training courses were organized benefiting 608 participating farmers.
- ▶ As Extension Activity, a total of 33 activities were organized and benefiting 770 farmers.





Cluster Frontline Demonstrations of Oilseeds 2019-20 under NFSM

In Cluster Front Line Demonstration on Oilseeds during 2019-20, total 1826 ha area was allotted with 4565 demonstration in 68 KVKs under Zone IX, during kharif, rabi and summer season. In Madhya Pradesh 45 KVKs covered for demonstration as soybean 380 ha, groundnut 10 ha, niger 60 ha, sesame 80 ha, mustard 320 ha, linseed 190 ha and sunflower 10 ha, similarly in Chhattisgarh 23

KVKs covered for demonstration as soybean 70 ha, groundnut 110, niger 80 ha, sesame 106 ha, sunflower 30 ha, mustard 180 ha, linseed 170 ha, safflower 30 ha going to be achieved during kharif, rabi and summer season by using soil testing, improved variety with seed treatment, line sowing, INM, IPM,ICM technologies. All the demonstration sites have GPS coordinates.





Cluster Frontline Demonstrations on Pulses 2019 under NFSM

During 2019 in Summer 986 demonstrations conducted in 430 ha area under CFLD Pulses in the operational states of Chhattisgarh and Madhya Pradesh. The demonstration has implemented through 18 KVKs in four pulses crops namely blackgram and greengram. In Madhya Pradesh 290 ha area achieved with 657 demonstrations whereas Chhattisgarh 140 ha area has achieved with 329 demonstrations during summer 2019.

In kharif 2019 season allotted 860 ha area with 2150 number of demonstration in 49 district in Madhya Pradesh. The Major crops are blackgram, greengram and pigeonpea. Similarly in Chhattisgarh total 540 ha area allotted with 1350 number of demonstration with 24 district. The Major crops in kharif season blackgram, greengram, pigeonpea & horsegram.





KMA Activities

Kisan mobile advisories in various thematic area in agriculture, horticulture, animal husbandry, fisheries, enterprise, home science weather are regular sent by KVKs to farmers in Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh. More than two million farmers were covered through mobile advisories by 62 KVKs through 730 messages comprising the subjects of crop, soil, livestock, farm

mechanization, home science, marketing, awareness etc. in the Zone IX during April to June, 2019. All KVKs under this institute are using mkisan portal for sending their mobile advisory. All the mobile network of villages in Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh are connected through KMA.
