through plantation being difficult due to severe drought and lack of irrigation Bellary region of Karnataka state, more emphasis is given to natural regeneration by section 2 to 3 weedings and soil working for the first 2 to 3 years followed by Hardy plants of the local species viz. Acacia nilotica, ssp. indica, and Prosopis spicigera become ready for exploitation in 30 years. pruning provide some early revenue through the sale of thorns, fodder, pods me also all wielding neem kernals. On maturity, the trees meet fuel, fodder and timber remains of the people.
