  - Deals with subabul (Leucaena leucocephala) as a source of organic manure. A stud conducted during 1984-92 near Chandigarh has shown that 5483 kg/ha (oven dry) mean annual organic manure could be obtained from this species. This is equivalent to 189. and 74 kg per ha of N, P, K. The value of these nutrients at the market rate was worked to be Rs. 1700/ha/year. In addition, Leucaena provided 16.4, 49.5 and 11 q/ha/year of twigs, branches and stem wood respectively and was also found effective for moist

conservation and protection against splash erosion.
