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sew concept of conservation ditching-a dual purpose terracing system-was experimented Bellary for four years since 1976. The results of the experimentation indicate that reservation ditching could act both as a terrace and a storage structure at the individual level eliminating the erstwhile problems. An annual maximum soil loss of 3.0 tonnes/ deposited in the ditches. The water collected in the ditches could easily be lifted by pumps and utilised for supplemental irrigation to rabi jowar in 1978 resulting in pressed yields of 46.8 and 36.8% grain and straw, respectively over the unirrigated crop. manulatum planted on the side slopes recorded a yield potential of 15.5 tonnes/ green matter.
