Net return obtained from Eucalyptus+Bhabar plantation were compared with net return from maize-wheat rotation under rainfed condition in Shiwalik foothills. During 9 years rotation, Eucalyptus+Bhabar gave net return of Rs. 7,910/ha/year. Maize-wheat rotation gave net return of Rs. 3,651/ha/year under the best land and water management practices. The B-C ratio for Eucalyptus+Bhabar plantation was 2.55 and for maizewheat rotation 2.08 at 10% discount rate.
