- The study conducted under laboratory conditions revealed that in black soils in Bellary region, application of 12000 kg/ha over a period of six years of well rotten farm yard manure neither increased the yield of jowar, cotton nor improved soil aggregation. Even an application of 50,000 kg/ha of well rotten farm yard manure did not materially improve aggregation. Possible reasons for lack of crop response and soil aggregation are discussed in the paper.
