Grass root studies have indicated that Pennisetum clandestinum, Tripogon brome Eragrostis amabilis and Cynodon dactylon are very good soil binders. Themeda Ischaemum ciliare and Paspalum dilatatum are also found to be good soil stabilized herb Centella asiatica, though developing a flat and dense canopy overground proved to be an efficient soil binder.
