The paper discusses the usefulness of kudzu (Pueraria thumbergiana) in soil conservation as it provides cover to denuded hill slopes, rebuilds the fertility of degraded lands and controls weeds. The work done at the Soil Conservation Farm has established that it could be successfully introduced on poor soils provided proper soil working techniques were used. Once established, it tends to grow vigorously.
