The paper describes how areas infested with Broom and Gorse, exotic shrubs, which grow wild over large areas in the Nilgiris, can be afforested with economic species. It was observed that these shrubs serve as a good nurse crop for the *Eucalyptus* and wattle seedlings. The method of plantations of these species in such areas is described in detail.
