In this paper, the authors discuss the problem of mass erosion through landslides, minesp and stream bank. The factors responsible for such problems are also enumerated. Reclamation techniques including engineering measures for slope stabilization and ground stabilization; measures for torrent training and restoration of degraded sites are described in greater details. The research findings in respect of eco-restoration of mined areas at Sahastradhara and landslide control project at Nalotanala in Mussoorie hills have been presented.
