Various soil and water conservation measures, both engineering and vegetative, adopted for reclamation of abandoned mined areas in hilly regions particularly the Sahastradhara area in Mussoorie hills, mined for limestone, have been described. These also include protective measures. The paper also discusses the impact of such measures on the restoration and improvement of the environment of these areas.
