- A small watershed (abandoned lime stone quarry) near Sahastradhara (Dehradun) was selected in 1983 for rehabilitation through soil and water conservation measures. These measures have resulted in reduction of runoff from 57 to 39.5% during monsoon period and have increased the flow during lean period from practically zero to about 800 cu m per day. The quality of water has also improved which is safe for drinking purposes.
