Watershed management plans for a few selected watersheds in Mohindergarh district of Haryana State were prepared in 1981 by the scientists of Central Soil & Water Conservation Research and Training Institute, Dehradun and its Research Centre, Chandigarh and executed under their technical supervision by the Drought Prone Area Programme Agency Narnaul. The villages for which the watershed management plans were prepared include Pali, Ganiyar, Bajar, Dedoli, Rampuri, Masit and Siha, and other villages. The bulleting divided into 5 parts as per different watersheds, gives an uptodate information, with illustrations, on the work done and achievements made in these backward areas of Aravali foothills. The results of practical utility and the important recommendations have also been summarized.
