The authors have attempted to determine districtwise growth trends in bovine population in Haryana during 1966-72, 1972-77 and 1977-82 inter-census periods. The study reveals that the compound growth rates for all categories of bovine population showed mixed trends during the three inter-census periods, which were more in favour of buffalo population in all the districts. The findings also indicated that adult cattle males are being fast replaced by adult buffalo males which have emerged as a multipurpose animal used for breeding, for ploughing and for haulage.
