The paper attempts to analyse the relative importance of three determinants viz., the contribution of number of milch animals, productivity of these animals and price of milk and their interactions towards the increase in total milk production in Haryana state over the period of 15 years (1966-67 to 1980-81). The pure price effect was highly pronounced in case of cow's milk which was followed by yield price interaction and pure yield effect. In case of buffaloes, the most pronounced effect came from price effect followed by interactions between number of milch animals and price effect and finally by pure number effect.
