Economic aspects of the reclamation of ravine lands through afforestation have been dealt with. It has been found that afforestation of ravine lands will provide net annual return of Rs. 1370 and Rs. 660/ha, if they are put under plantation of *Dendrocalamus strictus* and *Dalbergia sissoo*, respectively. Out of various species of *Eucalyptus* tried for afforestation, *E. camaldulensis* was found to be more rewarding.
