
# Message

ioined this Institute initially on 1st June 1999 as Principal Scientist (Horticulture) and continued till end of 2000. In January 2001. I was asked to take the charge of this Institute as Acting Director by H.Q. office A and continued till May 2002, and then I moved to National Research Centre for Grapes at Pune and superannuated from service on 31st May, 2013 after serving almost 11 years as Director of NRC Grapes, Pune. ICAR Reseach Complex for Goa has contributed a lot in the area of plantation crops as unit of Central Plantation Crops Research Institute at Kasargod from early 1976 till early 1989 when this became a separate unit/Institute of ICAR Research Complex for Goa initially as Union territory and then as State covering only two districts (North and South area) in Western Arabian Coastal area. 

Indeed it was a great pleasure that North Goa KVK attached to the Institute bagged the Best National KVK award during 2009. The Institute was also bestowed with Vasant Rao Naik award for outstanding Research and Application in dry land farming systems for the year 2008 besides other

recognitions and laurels. I place on record my sincere appreciations to all the dignitaries of the ICAR, Govt. of India, line departments, farmers and all my colleagues in the Institute for their constant support as a team to take the ICAR Research Complex for Goa to greater heights.

Goa and other coastal regions in India have carved a niche as internationally well known tourist destinations. Hence, it is imperative to persue research and ToT programmes which will pave the way for promoting Agro-eco-tourism by linking with main stream tourism to improve economic prosperity of farmers and all those involved in tourism industry.

With renaming as CCARI, the Institute has now a wider canvas on national perspective to gear up to the changing needs and aspirations of farming community in entire coastal region of the country. I wish and hope that the CCARI will bring in a paradigm shift by reorientation of its research and ToT programmes and hope by bringing smile on the face of farmers through its cutting edge technologies and guide the destiny of farming community at large in the entire coastal areas. 

INDIAN Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) established the ICAR Research Complex for Goa in April, 1976 to cater to the needs of agricultural research of Goa region. The Research Centres were started in 1975 in Goa and Lakshadweep under the Scheme for Establishment of Agricultural and Animal Science Research Stations in centrally sponsored areas. Subsequently, these Research Stations have become the Regional Stations of Central Plantation Crops Institute (CPCRI) during 1976. This Research Complex, which was under the administrative and technical control of the CPCRI, Kasaragod, Kerala has been upgraded as an independent Institute from April, 1989. Since then, it is working on all aspects of agricultural and allied sciences to cater to the needs of Goa.

Shri. A.R. Battacharya, Scientist (Animal Reproduction) and Dr. M. Haridasan, Junior Scientist (Soil Science) were the two scientists who were posted during the initial establishment of this Regional Station under CPCRI, Kasaragod, Kerala. The office of the Regional Station, Goa was housed in Borda at Margao. Field experiments were conducted at the Kalay farm of the Department of Agriculture, Govt. of Goa. In the year 1976, a project on Soil testing and Plant analysis for plantation crops was initiated at Goa. Later during 1976, Dr. D.G. Dhandar, Scientist S-1 (Horticulture), Dr. N.P.S. Varde, Senior Research Assistant along with Ms. Jane Francis Mary Lewis as Superintendent served at the Goa centre. Later during 1977, two more scientists *viz.*, Dr. K.D. Singh, Scientist S-1 (Soil Science) and Dr.N.S.Nair, Scientist S-1 (Poultry Science) were posted at Goa station during the year. One more scientist Dr. Madan Gopal Gupta, joined as Scientist S-1 and later left during the same year. During 1978, Dr. R.C. Mandal took over as Joint Director of ICAR Research Complex for Goa under CPCRI and continued up to 9.12.1982 as first Jt. Director of Goa complex.

Later during 1982, ICAR RC for Goa was shifted to Ela, Old Goa and also a KVK was started during 1983 under ICAR RC, Goa. Dr.A.R. Bhattacharya was Scientist In charge upto 1985. During 1985, **Dr. K.Venugopal became the second Joint Director of ICAR RC for Goa.** To accommodate various research and training activities, an additional area of 34.4 ha has been acquired during 1987 enhancing the total area of the Institute to 53.80 ha.

Consequent to the **up-gradation of the complex in to an Institute in April, 1989**, the first Annual Staff Research Council meeting was organized on 9<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> April, 1990 at Ela, Old Goa. Dr. K.L. Chadha, DDG (Hort.) chaired the plenary session. **Dr. D.G. Dhandar** was transferred to ICAR RC as Jt. Director on 8.5.1989 and later on 16.6.1989, he was redesignated as Officer on Special Duty (OSD) to ICAR RC for Goa which he continued up to 1994 and then became regular **First Director of this Complex** which he continued to hold up to 22.01.2001.



As a prelude to the up-gradation, a National Workshop on Evolving Strategies on Agriculture, Animal Husbandry and Fisheries in Goa was held on 14<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> February, 1989, in which experts in various field from all over the country participated. The state of art, scope and strategies for future development were discussed during this workshop and new thrust areas were identified for taking up during VIII five year plan period (1991-92 to 1996-97). During the up-gradation, the Institute was having 10 scientists with one OSD.

Later **Dr. P.G. Adsule** was **acting Director** from 23.1.2001 to 24.1.2002 followed by **Dr. V.S. Korikanthimath,** who was the **second regular Director** of this Institute from 25.1.2002 and continued till 28.2.2010. **Dr. Narendra Pratap Singh is the current and third Director** of the Institute from 2.3.2010 to till date.

At present, the Institute is headed by Director with 20 scientists working in five sections *viz.*, Resource Management and Integrated Production, Crop Science, Horticulture Science, Animal Science and Fishery Science.

## Krishi Vigyan Kendra

#### Introduction

Krishi Vigyan Kendra was sanctioned by ICAR during 1983. It was actually started functioning from 1st April, 1984 under ICAR Research

Complex for Goa, Ela, Old Goa which was then under the administrative control of Central Plantation Crops Research Institute, Kasaragod. From 1989 since ICAR Research Complex was elevated to full fledged research Institute. KVK was directly under the control of ICAR Research Complex for Goa which was declared as host Institute for KVK, and the Director, ICAR Research Complex is now Chairman of the Scientific Advisory Committee of KVK being host Institute. Initially KVK was functioning in host Institute building i. e. from 1984 to 2001. It was shifted to farmers hostel in 2002. In the year 2005 an administrative building of KVK was constructed and thereafter it started functioning from new building. From 1984 to 2005, KVK was catering to the needs of whole Goa state. After starting of separate KVK for South Goa in 2005, this KVK is now catering exclusively for North Goa. This is technically attached to Zone VIII which is located in Bangalore. Zonal Project Director, Zone VIII is the technical head of this KVK.



About 20 ha of land have been earmarked for KVK in block C of

ICAR Research Complex for Goa. KVK is headed by Programme Coordinator and assisted by 6 Subject Matter Specialist in the discipline of Agronomy, Horticulture, Plant Protection, Home Science, Animal Science and Agriculture Extension. Team of Computer Programmer, Lab Technician and Farm Manager is also assisting Programme Coordinator. - Conducting vocational trainings to develop entrepreneurships.



- Production and supply of various inputs such as seeds, planting materials, breeds, *Trichoderma viride* (Bio control agents), Spawn, Vermicompost, Earthworms, etc.
- Farm advisory services
- Diagnostic visits
- Technology dissemination through lectures, demonstration, displays, publications, *etc* at various forum. Creating awareness through conducting various extension activities like Kisan mela, seminars, symposiums, farmers meets, workshops, field days, exhibition, etc.

#### **Major Achievement & Important Technologies Transferred**

#### 1. On farm testing:

Under this programme 521 trials were conducted covering 51.25 ha area till January, 2015.

#### 2. Front line demonstration:

Under this programme total 759.15 ha area has been covered on various enterprises, and 3,231 farmers are benefited till January, 2015.

#### 3. Training programmes:

A total of 2,658 training programmes for farm men and women, rural youth and extension functionaries were conducted in which 43,545 personnel participated till January, 2015.

#### 4. Planting material production:

In all 3,75,044 Nos. grafts/seedlings of various crops like mango, cashew, coconut, arecanut, drum stick, etc. prepared in nursery and supplied to needy farmers at reasonable cost till January, 2015.

#### 5. Other extension activities conducted:

Some of other important extension activities are being conducted to create awareness and popularize technologies till January, 2015.
