

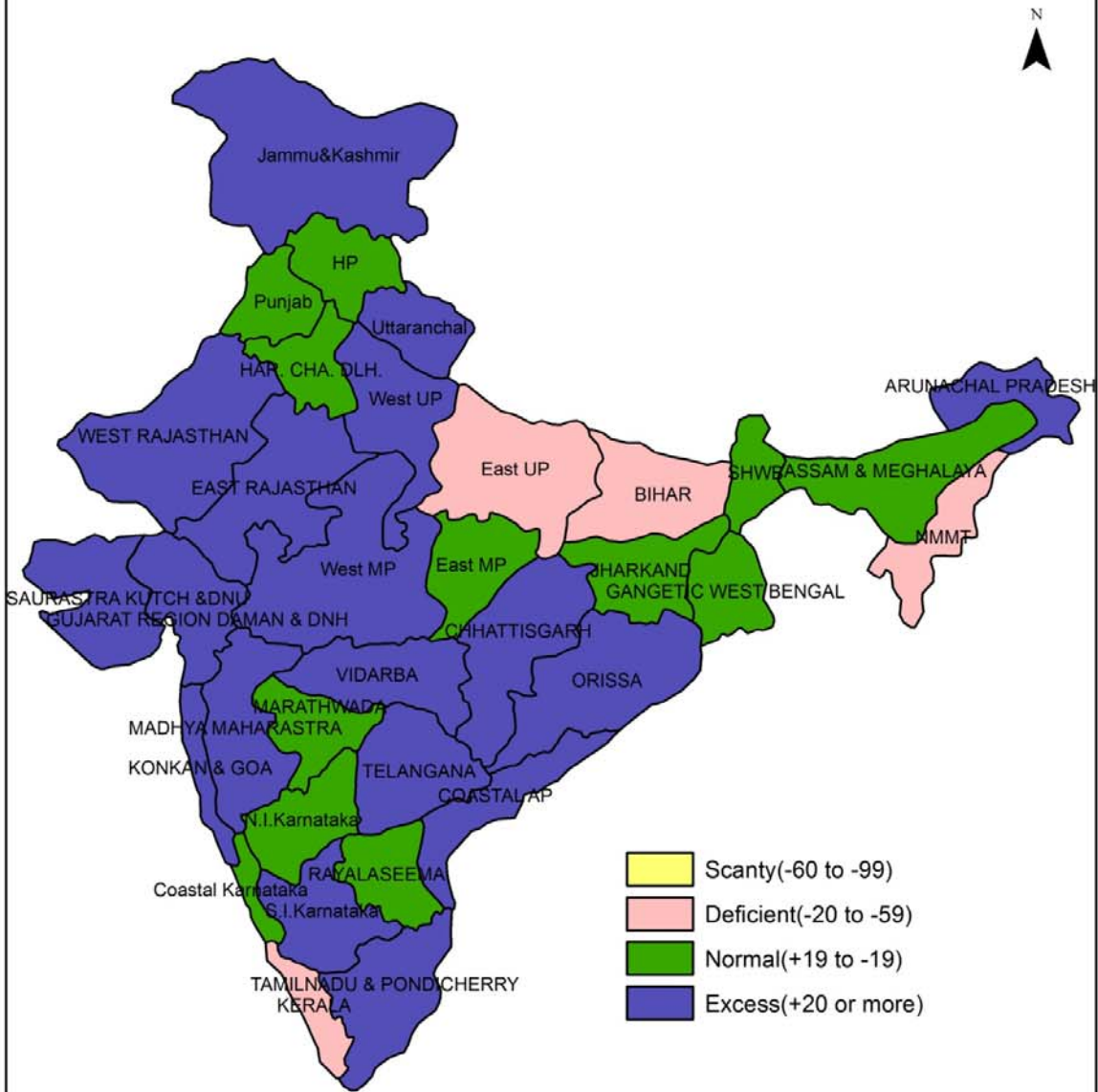
- Monsoon has covered the entire country on 26 June. Onset over remaining areas of West Rajasthan was declared on 26 June, which is 19 days a head of normal.
