





COVID-19 GUIDELINES FOR FISHING AND FISH HANDLING



Wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds OR use an alcohol-based disinfectant before and after fishing



Keep same and minimum crew for daily fishing operation, avoid unknown crew onboard



Fishers with travel history, cough, fever and cold should avoid fishing activity



Cough and sneeze into your elbow, NOT your hand and disinfect hands after coughing/sneezing



Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth without washing your hands first



Avoid crowd in fish sale area/ market and keep social distance



Storage of fish or ice in beach and open grounds should be avoided



Fish handling including loading, unloading, icing and packing should be with minimum contact



Use disinfected clean crates/insulated boxes and utensils



Use masks in fish stalls and sanitize hands before and after each sale



Disinfect boat deck and utensils after every operation with soap and water



Keep personal hygiene and maintain healthy habits







Ensure Hand Hygiene

Advise fishing crew to wash hands with soap and water or rub with alcohol-based hand sanitizer



Operate fishing which requires minimum crew

Avoid smoking, chewing pan, tobacco & spitting

Ensure Personal Hygiene

Wear clean, protective clothes, masks head gear and gloves.

➤ Do not cough or sneeze or spit on Fish or ice.



Wash deck, fishing gears, and equipments with detergent or disinfectants

Screen for high temperature at entry

Make sure all the crews are healthy and do not have any flu like symptoms
