Regular Training Programme for Officers

During the year 2015-16 two batches of regular training courses were conducted for officers at Dehradun in which 47 officers from 10 States across the country of the 5th and 6th batches of 4 months (originally 112th & 113th batches) were trained. Upto March 2016, 2816 officers have been trained at HQrs. Dehradun, its regional centres at Bellary, Kota and Udhagamandalam. The State-wise representation of the officers trained at Dehradun during 2015-16 were Assam - 8, Chhattisgarh – 16, Kerala - 4, Jammu & Kashmir - 1, Punjab - 2, Madhya Pradesh - 3, Maharashtra – 5, Nagaland - 2, Uttarakhand – 5 and Uttar Pradesh - 1. Upto March 2016, 5547 Graduate Assistants have been trained at Reseach Centres.

Short Courses
