

179. **Bhushan, L.S. and Om Prakash. 1990.** Cropping pattern for reclaimed ravine lands of Yamuna river. Post Symp. Proc. Internl. Symp. on "Water Erosion, Sedimentation and Resource Conservation", Oct. 09-13, 1990, Dehradun: 137-141.

Under rainfed condition at Agra, double cropping system of greengram-mustard ensures stability in production and an average return of about Rs. 9,300/ha/annum. Castor (*Ricinus communis*) proved more beneficial than pigeonpea (*Cajanus cajan*). Under irrigated conditions, clusterbean-wheat cropping proved promising. Under limited irrigation, intercropping of mustard in potato (2:1) is more remunerative.
