

208. **Dayal, R. and Kale, M.V. 1976.** Mixed cropping with 'Hy-4' cotton. *Indian J. Agric. Sci.*, 46(9):421-423.

The study conducted during 1972-74 at Vasad (Gujarat) on intercropping with cotton indicated that cotton (Hy-4) when grown mixed with leguminous and non-leguminous crops in 2 and 3 rows without extra inputs, its yield and monetary returns were adversely affected. However, leguminous crops were better choice than the non-leguminous ones for intercropping systems.
