The paper deals with the degraded lands and erosion hazards in the hilly regions of peninsular India. It provides statistical data with regard to total area, population, irrigated area, forest area, problem area, treated area and characteristics of hilly regions in different States located in the Indian peninsula. The paper also describes specific soil and water conservation measures, watershed management practices for each State, different land slopes, rainfed areas and suggests future development programmes for these regions.
