The book, in Hindi, deals with rainfed farming, selection and cultivation of suitable crops, scientific management of land as per its capability and other related issues, on the basis of varying agro-climatic conditions as prevailing in different regions and States of India. In the rainfed areas, the crop production is very low mainly due to faulty agronomic practices which the farmers conventionally follow, coupled with high rates of soil erosion as a result of non-adoption of proper soil and water conservation measures. In the book, suitable soil conservation measures and improved practices have been suggested region/statewise. In the concluding part, a chapter has specially been devoted to water harvesting/storage and its recycling as per the local conditions of different regions, for increasing the production in these areas.
