The article suggests that with proper choice of hardy rootstocks of fruit plants, wastelands could be made economically productive and rewarding. Characteristics of about thirty rootstodies adaptable to adverse soil and climatic reactions have been described for selection of suitable rootstock combination of different fruit plants like apple, apricot, almond, pear, peaches, plants like apple, apple mango, citrus, guava, jujube and others.
