Results of a study conducted at Dehradun on runoff and soil loss in plots having 11% and the cover of strawberry, pineapple and pomegranate are presented. Superior pineapple as an erosion checking type was indicated. Results showed that by allowed natural weeds to grow during the rainy season, the soil loss can be reduced to a great extension without imparting significant adverse effect on the plant growth.
