To ascertain adaptability and economic viability of fruit-types on poor and broken topography of ravine lands, cultivars of fruit-types such as *ber* (*Zizyphus mauritiana* Lamk), *Citrus reticulata*, mosambi (*Citrus sineosis*), lemon (*Citrus limon*), karaunda (*Carissa carandus*) papaya (*Carica papaya*) and peach (*Prunus persica*) were planted at different locations of ravine lands. Most of the fruits were found performing well and among these *ber* and papaya appeared most promising generating quick returns from ravine lands.
