A survey conducted at Agra in ravineous tract of Jamuna showed that eleven dominant grass spp. were emerging in distinct colonies with the result of 13 years closure and these included Apluda aristata, Cenchrus ciliaris, Cymbopogon jwarancusa, Cynodon dactylon Desmostachya bipinnata, Dichanthium annulatum, Eleusine compressa, Eramopogor strictus, Heteropogon contortus, Panicum antidotale and Saccharum bengalense. Habitat socio-economic value, per cent composition and yield of dominant grass species have been discussed.
