A dug out farm pond was constructed in 1959-1960 at Bellary (Karnataka) to collect runoff and recycle it to overcome moisture stress during crop growth. An evaluation study reveals that additional crop benefits from the system as a whole are maximum when 5 cm of runoff is applied to *rabi jowar* at the start of mild stress.
