Causes and control of landslides and landslips by various methods have been discussed. This can be achieved by an Act of law (Soil and Water Management Act), educating the general public and children by radio talks, television broadcasts, exhibitions, bulletins, popular articles describing the need for protecting the hills from the landslides. In extreme cases, fencing the stabilized landslides and providing watch and ward may be necessary. Transfer of technology is an important aspect of the project. This can be achieved by training at various levels in the control of landslides and landslips.
