Soil and water conservation measures carried out in the Sukhomajri watershed near Chandigarh have been discussed. The surplus rain water from the hills, collected behind an earthen dam and given for limited irrigation to the farmers, increased crop yields manifold. The village is now not only self-sufficient in food, fodder, fuel and milk but is also having surplus to sell outside for additional income. A village level Hill Resources Management Society has been constituted. The objectives, functions and responsibilities of the Society have been outlined in the paper.
