**Watershed Planning and Development for Red Soils (G.R.Halli, Chitradurga)**

The publication gives a detailed account of all developmental works including planning and surveying leading to formulation of master plan, its execution and achievements made in the operational research project carried out in an area of 314 ha at G.R.Halli, Chitradurga district of Karnataka State on the basis of integrated watershed management. On completion of the project, the analysis of results indicated positive trend in the economy as a result of soil and water conservation measures and restoring ecological balance implying that the project was successful. It has been suggested that the priority of the works should be decided based on the needs of local people; it is no doubt a people's programme, but they would participate emotionally only when economic security is ensured; and the production oriented programmes must be taken up very quickly so that the people are convinced of the
