In this paper, the authors have attempted to make economic analysis of different soil and water conservation measures adopted in various watershed development programmes in India. The analyses indicate that most of conservation measures are economically viable with benefit-cost ratio of more than 1.2. Among the alternatives, water harvesting and its recycling gave intangible benefits which are quite substantial.
