

आमुख

प्रत्यक्ष लाभ अंतरण (डीबीटी) भारत सरकार की एक पहल है जिसका उद्देश्य मुख्य रूप से विचौलियों को खत्म करना और लाभार्थियों को सीधा लाभ देना है। कृषि अनुसंधान और शिक्षा विभाग (डेयर) के तहत, विभिन्न योजनाओं में किसान, छात्र और संकाय सदस्य इसके लाभार्थी हैं। डेयर में 20 ऐसी योजनाएं हैं, जहां लाभार्थियों को नकद या अन्य तरह के रूप में लाभ मिलता है। इस परियोजना में डेयर के अंतर्गत डीबीटी योजनाओं के तहत व्यक्तिगत लेनदेन के रिकॉर्ड को इकट्ठा करने के लिए एक वेब आधारित प्रबंधन सूचना प्रणाली (एमआईएस) (<https://dbtdare.icar.gov.in>) विकसित किया गया है। इस एमआईएस को आईसीएआर के भारतीय कृषि सांख्यिकी अनुसंधान संस्थान के डेटा सेंटर में होस्ट किया गया है। यह ऑनलाइन एप्लिकेशन डॉट नेट फ्रेमवर्क का उपयोग करके विकसित की गई है और यह राष्ट्रीय स्तर डीबीटी भारत पोर्टल के साथ आंकड़ों के आदान-प्रदान के लिए वेब सेवा का उपयोग करता है।

डेयर की सभी 20 डीबीटी योजनाओं को डीबीटी भारत पोर्टल पर दिखाया गया है और डीबीटी डेयर एमआईएस के माध्यम से मासिक प्रगति रिपोर्ट सभी योजनाओं की प्राप्त की जा रही है। इस एमआईएस में कई रिपोर्टें विकसित की गई हैं जिसमें उन संस्थाओं के लिए जो सूचना अपलोड करने के लिए उपयोग करते हैं और दूसरी उन प्रबंधकों के लिए जो एमआईएस में डेटा स्थिति की निगरानी करते हैं। यह एमआईएस समय, ऊर्जा और धन की काफी बचत करता है और प्रभावी एवं कुशलता पूर्वक जानकारी प्रदान करता है। यह डेयर की विभिन्न डीबीटी योजनाओं के तहत फंड ट्रांसफर में स्पष्टता प्रदान करता है। आईसीएआर में कृषि शिक्षा और कृषि विस्तार संभाग इस एमआईएस का उपयोग करके प्रभावी रूप से डीबीटी योजनाओं से संबंधित आंकड़े एवं सूचना का प्रबंधन और निगरानी कर रहे हैं।

हम निदेशक, भा.कृ.अनु.प.-भा.कृ.सां.अ.सं. के ऋणी हैं जिन्होंने इस शोध परियोजना में गहरी दिलचस्ती ली और आवश्यक सुविधाएं जुताई। धन सहायता के लिए हम कृषि शिक्षा प्रभाग, आईसीएआर के आभारी हैं।

PREFACE


Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) is an initiative of Government of India (GoI) for transfer of benefits in all government schemes directly to the beneficiaries. In the Department of Agricultural Research and Education (DARE)-Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), a total of twenty (20) schemes are covered under DBT wherein the beneficiaries are farmers, students and faculty member and the benefits type are both as cash and in kind. In this project, a web based Management Information System (MIS) (<https://dbtdare.icar.gov.in>) to manage the DBT records of beneficiary in different schemes of DARE-ICAR has been developed and hosted in the ICAR Data Centre at Indian Agricultural Statistics Research Institute (IASRI), New Delhi. This application is developed using .NET framework and uses web service for data exchange with national level DBT Bharat portal (<https://dbtbharat.gov.in>).

DBT DARE Management Information System has been developed and integrated with the DBT Bharat Portal through web service. All the 20 DBT applicable schemes of DARE-ICAR identified have been on-boarded on DBT Bharat Portal and are required to upload MPR through DBT DARE MIS. A number of reports formats have been developed in the MIS both for the individual organizations and the scheme managers for monitoring of the information in the system. This system will considerably save time, energy and money through transaction costs reduction and acquire the information in a cost effective manner. Education Division, ICAR is effectively managing and monitoring the DBT Schemes of DARE-ICAR using this MIS.

We are indebted to the Director, ICAR-IASRI for taking keen interest in this Research Project and for providing necessary facilities. Thanks are also due to the Agricultural Education Division, ICAR for providing the funding support.

CHAPTER I: INTRODUCTION & REVIEW OF LITERATURE

Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) was started in 2013 in India as a major reform in the government delivery system by re-engineering the existing process in welfare schemes. It was started for simpler and faster flow of information/funds to ensure accurate targeting of the beneficiaries and reducing duplication and fraud in government schemes. The DBT Mission under the Cabinet Secretarial, GoI is the nodal point for the implementation of the DBT programmes across all the ministries in the Government of India. Electronic Payment Framework was laid down for all Ministries/Departments and their attached Institutions/PSUs and is applicable on all Central Sector (CS)/Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS) and for schemes where components of cash are transferred to individual beneficiaries. Since aadhaar number provides unique identity and is useful in targeting the intended beneficiaries, aadhaar number is preferred and beneficiaries are encouraged to have aadhaar numbers. DBT is the high priority and focus area of the Government. A DBT Bharat portal (<https://dbtbharat.gov.in/>) was launched in 2016 as a platform for management of all DBT applicable schemes related information. The portal has information regarding the scheme, beneficiaries and fund transfer details. All the documents pertaining to the DBT are also made available in this portal.

Over the last decade, there has been tremendous global attention on cash transfers from governments to citizens directly as a means of addressing poverty, inequality and other desirable policy goals. The attention was spurred by the success of large cash transfer programmes in the United States of America, which were found to be highly effective. It is evident in some cases that cash transfer programmes have been able to mitigate poverty, reduce inequality, improve school enrolment and increase women's access to health services. The success of such interventions especially in Brazil (through Bolsa Família programme launched in November, 2003) and Mexico led to numerous studies on cash transfer programmes in other parts of the world, making it one of the most studied forms of antipoverty interventions in the recent decades (The World Bank, 2014). The Brazilian government has also developed a portal viz. Portal da Transparência (Union General Controller, 2004) which is dedicated to make all expenditures (including Bolsa Família) of the federal government, public. The portal was aimed to ensure the proper and correct application of public resources. It has a list of all expenses and money

transfers the federal government has made, including the list of all the people receiving Bolsa Família benefits and how much they have received.

Official benefits website of the U.S. government viz. Benefits.gov (formerly GovBenefits.gov) was launched in 2002 to reduce the expense and difficulty of interacting with the government while increasing citizen access to benefit information. Operated, managed and supported by a Federal agency partnership, Benefits.gov provides an innovative, technology-based solution to benefit information delivery. The beneficiaries include U.S. citizens, businesses and Federal and state government entities. Benefits.gov is a cross-governmental collaboration between 17 Federal agencies referred to as 'Partners.' The site's core function is the eligibility prescreening questionnaire or "Benefit Finder." Answers to the questionnaire are used to evaluate a citizen's situation and compare it with the eligibility criteria for more than 1,200 Federally-funded benefit and assistance programs. Each program description provides citizens with the next steps to apply for any benefit program of interest. The site also features a recommendation engine that customizes the user's search for benefits based on their location or interest in a particular category.

In Indian context, various e-governance initiatives have been taken up in the field of agriculture both by ICAR and Department of Agriculture & Cooperation and Farmers Welfare. Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVK) Knowledge Network (<https://kvk.icar.gov.in/>), popularly known as KVK Portal (ICAR-IASRI 2016) helps in monitoring the functioning of KVKs at the National level and in providing timely information and advisory to the farmers. The aim of the portal is to transfer the technologies developed by the agricultural scientists to the farmers in a fast and effective manner using web and mobile technology (Pal *et al.* 2019) as well as to monitor the activities of KVKs. National Agriculture Market (eNAM) is a pan-India electronic trading portal (<https://enam.gov.in/web/>) (Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare, Government of India 2016) which networks the existing Agricultural Produce Market Committee (APMC) mandis to create a unified national market for agricultural commodities. The aim of the portal is to promote uniformity in agriculture marketing by streamlining of procedures across the integrated markets, removing information asymmetry between buyers and sellers and promoting real time price discovery based on actual demand and supply. Farmers' Portal (<https://farmer.gov.in/>) (Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare, Government of India 2016) is designed to create one stop

shop for meeting all informational needs relating to Agriculture, Animal Husbandry and Fisheries sectors production, sale/storage of an Indian farmer. Through this portal a farmer can get all relevant information on specific subjects around his village/block/district or state. This information is delivered in the form of text, SMS, email and audio/video in the language the farmer understands. Farmers can ask specific queries as well as give valuable feedback through the Feedback module specially developed for the purpose. KRISHI (Knowledge based Resources Information Systems Hub for Innovations in Agriculture) Portal (<https://krishi.icar.gov.in/>) (ICAR 2016) is an initiative of ICAR to bring its knowledge resources to all stakeholders at one place. The portal is being developed as a centralized data repository system of ICAR consisting of Technology, Data generated through Experiments/Surveys/Observational studies, Geo-spatial data, Publications, Learning Resources etc.

DARE-ICAR under the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare coordinates and promotes agricultural research and education in the country. There are 20 different DBT applicable schemes which are presently running in DARE-ICAR. The schemes include student centric schemes. i.e. various scholarships and fellowships, faculty schemes and farmer centric schemes. Out of the total 20 schemes, 19 are related to agricultural education/ research wherein the benefit type is cash and in agricultural extension scheme, the benefit type is in kind. The schemes are implemented and monitored by the scheme managers and is implemented in various ICAR institutes, Agricultural Universities and other organizations across the country (Table 1.1). Each Institution/agricultural university is required to provide the information with respect to the schemes being implemented at their organization. A Monthly Progress Report (MPR) of each scheme is submitted on DBT Bharat portal on a stipulated date every month. For management and reporting of scheme related information with respect to the beneficiary and transaction for all the twenty on boarded schemes of DARE-ICAR, a Management Information System (MIS) (<https://dbtdare.icar.gov.in/>) is developed at the national level.

CHAPTER II: METHODOLOGY

2.1 Technology used in DBT DARE Management Information System (MIS)

The DBT DARE Management Information System (MIS) has been developed based on 3-Tier Architecture using the following technology

- a. ASP.NET framework 4.5
- b. SQL Server 2012 used for database
- c. Visual studio 2013 as Integrated Development Environment (IDE)

The 3-tier architecture which is a form of client-server architecture, has been used to develop the MIS in which the functional processes viz. logic, data access, data storage and user interface are maintained as independent modules on separate platforms. It provides many benefits for production and development environments by modularizing the user interface, business logic, and data storage. In the present system, there are three layers viz.,

- a. **Presentation layer:** It is the front end layer in the 3-tier system and consists of the user interface. This layer is built on web technologies such as HTML5, JavaScript and CSS.
- b. **Application layer:** This layer is consisting of the functional business logic which drives an application's core capabilities. It has been constructed using C# language.

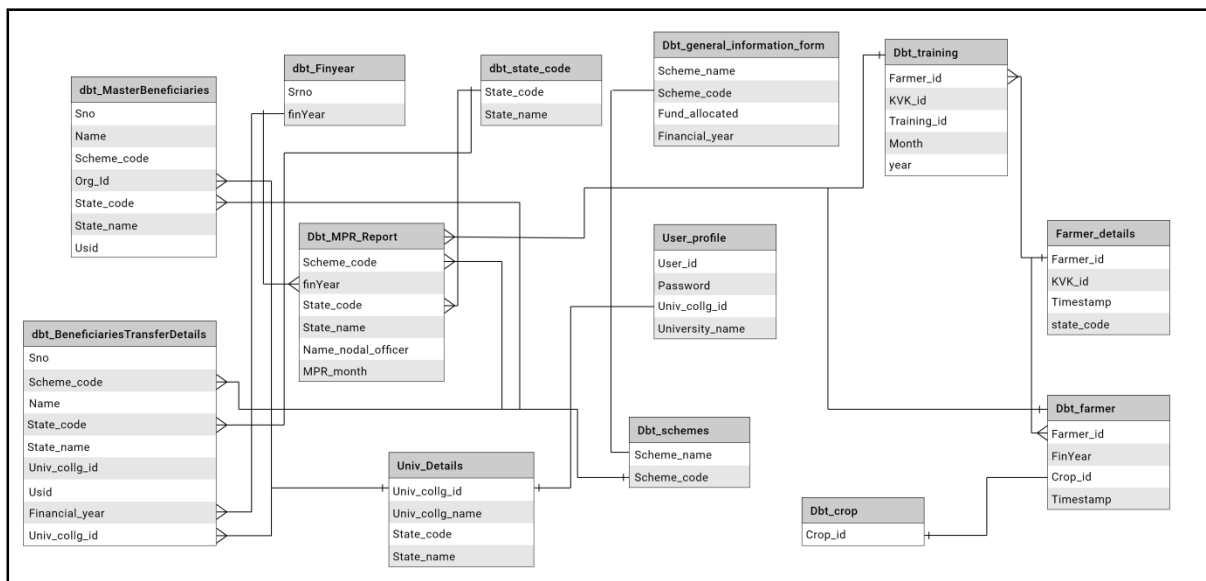


Fig. 2.1 ER Diagram of the DBT DARE MIS

- c. **Data layer:** This layer depicts the database/data storage system and data access layer. In the present system, Microsoft SQL Server 2012 is used. Table 2.1 depicts the name of the database tables along with their brief description. Figure 2.1 shows the ER diagram of the database used in the present system.

With the introduction of DBT DARE MIS, each university/ institute can upload the information online. First, their authentication is checked in the system followed by uploading of information on respective schemes. The entire process has many steps which are described below:

2.2 Beneficiaries information

For each of the organization, there exists a list of master beneficiaries which are maintained by that organization only. Thus, it is not needed to create/upload details of same beneficiary multiple times. Duplication check has been provided on Aadhaar Number (for Indian citizens), passport number, USID (exclusively for students). For students related schemes, there are two different excel templates for Indian and foreign students through which the beneficiary details can be uploaded in the system. For the schemes like ICAR Emeritus Scientist, ICAR Emeritus Professor, separate excel template has been developed to capture information on Professor/Scientist/ National Fellow (figure 2.2). After uploading the excel file users can view and edit the uploaded data (in case of any discrepancy) and then submit. Provision to upload individual beneficiary data is also provided in the system (figure 2.3). In case of a beneficiary leaving or already left the organization, for example, passed out students, retired professor etc., a provision to activate/deactivate individual beneficiary at any point of time by the respective organization is provided in the system (figure 2.4).

Instruction to Upload Beneficiary Details

Steps to Upload

1. Login using user id & password
2. [Download the excel template](#) . Data is to be filled in excel template in that particular format only. Excel file contains two sheets out of which only first sheet is required to be filled. After filling the data save the excel file (**Microsoft office 2010 onwards is supported for excel file creation**).

2.3 Transaction Information

After uploading the information on individual beneficiary in the system, transaction details of individual beneficiary can be uploaded in the system on monthly basis. There are two types of provisions in the system to upload this information; transaction details can be filled individually (figure 2.5) as well as bulk transaction information can also be entered. Figure 2.6 shows the bulk transaction uploaded under the scheme AgEdn – IASRI scholarship for MSc and PhD for the month of June in financial year 2018-19.

Out of total 20 schemes, data for 19 schemes are uploaded in DBT DARE MIS, however, for the Agriculture Extension scheme the data is transferred from the *Krishi Vigyan Kendra Knowledge Network Portal* (<https://kvk.icar.gov.in>). The individual KVK fills the data related to training, Front Line Demonstration (FLD) and On Farm Trial (OFT) in the KVK Portal. This information is collated in the ATARI (Agricultural Technology Application Research Institute) level and then at the Agriculture Extension Division, ICAR HQ level where the information is approved before its transfer to the DBT DARE MIS.

2.4 Monthly Progress Report (MPR)

The data uploaded by the stakeholders are summed up scheme-wise in the system. This is the Monthly Progress Report (MPR) based on certain parameters viz. total number of beneficiaries (cumulative for the financial year), total number of transactions (monthly basis) and total fund transfer/expenditure (monthly basis). The general information viz. Status of Scheme MIS, Overall Scheme Budget, DBT Applicable Component Fund Allocation etc. for each of the schemes is maintained by the Nodal Officer, DBT Cell, DARE-ICAR (figure 2.7). Thus, a total of twenty (20) MPRs are generated for all the schemes in the system automatically on monthly basis (figure 2.8). This data under each scheme is approved by the DBT Cell (DARE-ICAR) every month before it is transferred to the DBT Bharat portal. Figure 2.9 shows the MPR data approval page for the scheme AgEdn - Student READY for the financial year 2018-19. ‘View Data’ is appeared for the months against which the MPR have already been approved whereas ‘Approve Data’ is appeared for the month for which the MPR data has still not approved.

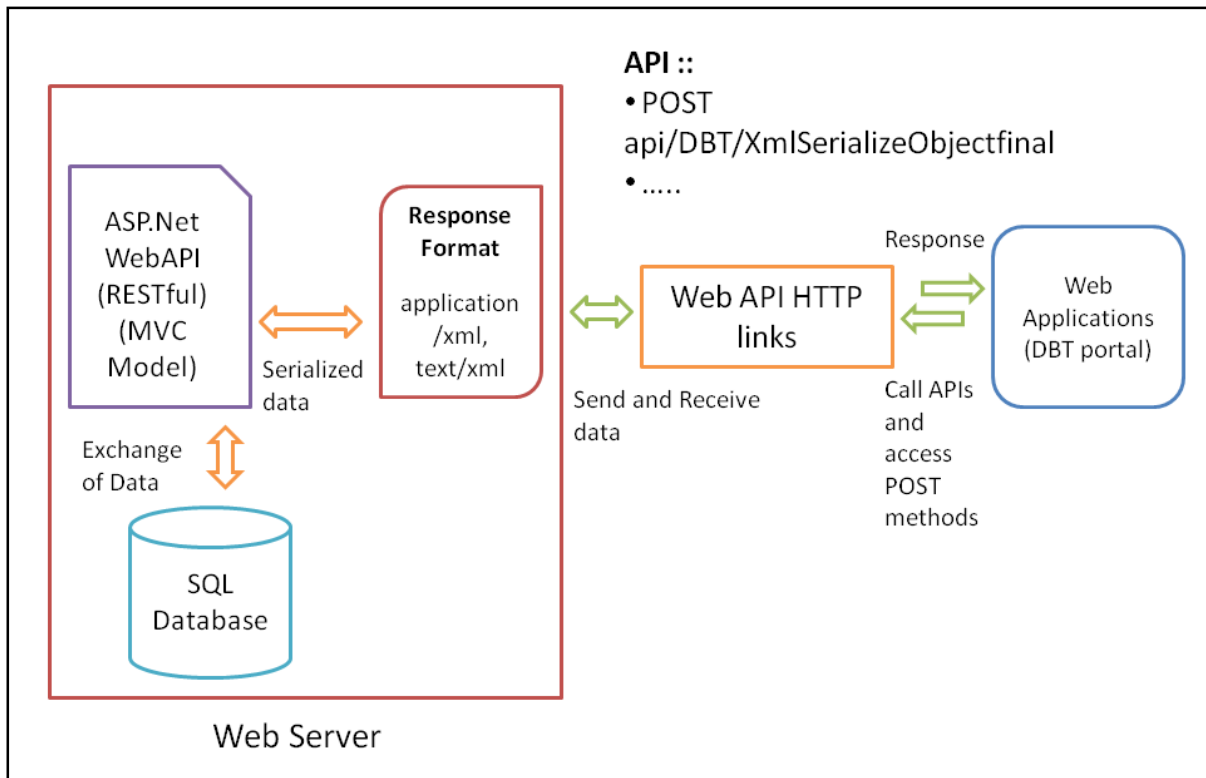


Fig. 2.15 DBT DARE WebAPI Architectural diagram

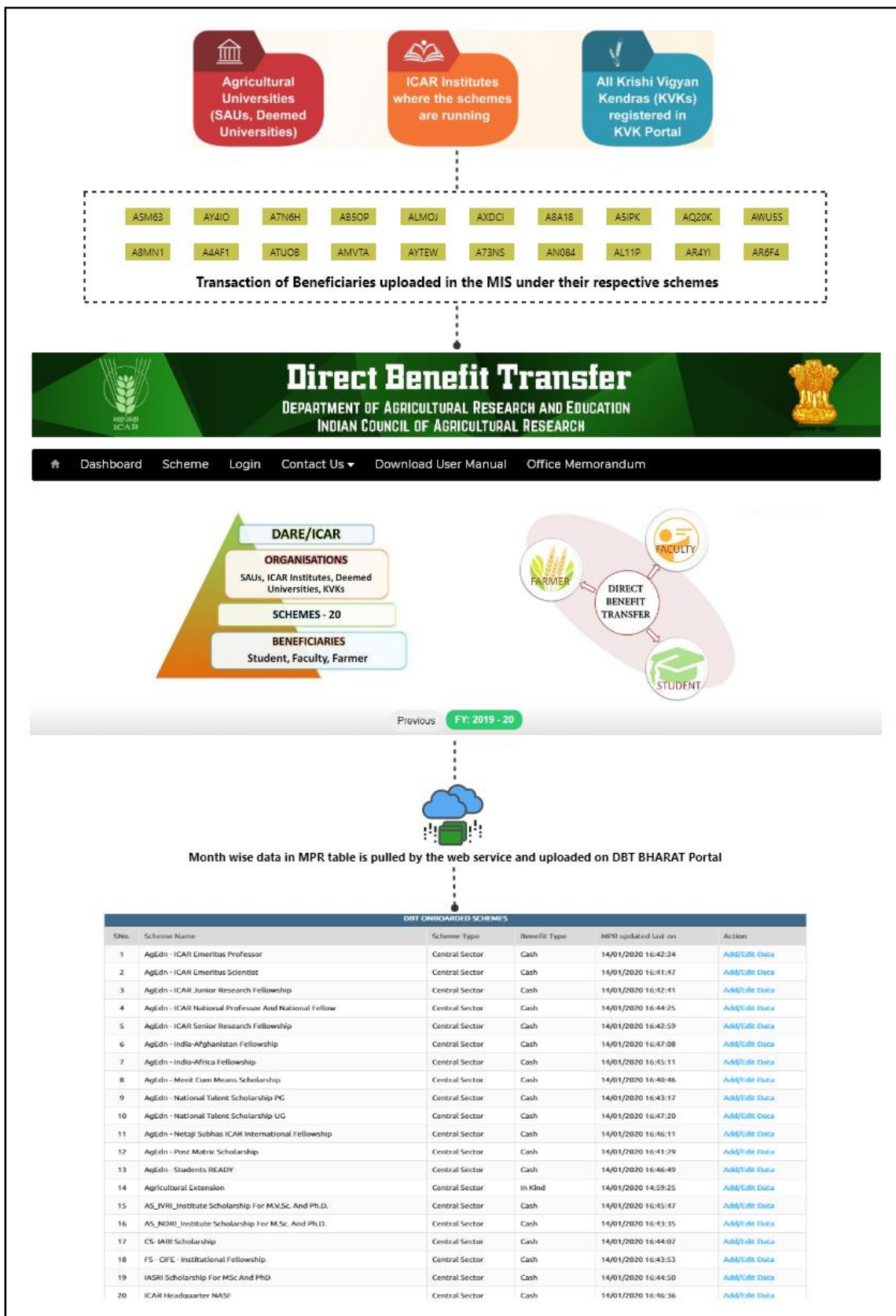


Fig. 2.16 Workflow of data uploading in to DBT Bharat through DBT DARE MIS

The monthly progress report information is pulled by DBT Mission of India (<https://dbtbharat.gov.in/>) on a prefixed date and time to update the same in the national level DBT Bharat Portal. This data pulling is done by a scheduler through web service. The data exchange between two portals is done through Web Application Programming Interface (WebAPI) (Block *et al.*, 2014). In the present scenario, Representational State Transfer (REST) APIs (Kurtz and Wortman, 2014) has been used for sharing of data. In DBT DARE MIS, the WebAPIs have been developed using ASP.NET framework 4.5 Model-View-Controller (MVC) model. The output of the API can be in JavaScript Object Notation (JSON) or Extensible Markup Language (XML) format as per need of the client. In the present system, XML output format is used. To get the output in XML, the data needs to be serialised, therefore, XmlSerializer class is used (Bornstein, 2004) for data exchange in the present MIS. This serialization technique turns the data in the application into XML that is transmitted between clients and services. Figure 2.15 shows the architecture of API used in DBT DARE MIS. Figure 2.16 depicts the entire workflow of data uploading in to DBT Bharat through DBT DARE MIS.

CHAPTER III: RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

3.1 DBT scheme reporting module

A number of reports have been developed in the MIS both for the individual organizations and the scheme managers for monitoring of the information in the system.

3.1.1 Reports for individual organization

For individual organization, there are 2 reports available in the MIS:

- i) Beneficiary report (figure 3.1) and
- ii) Transaction report (figure 3.2).

In the beneficiary report, individual organization can select a particular scheme to view the beneficiary details data that has been already uploaded in the online system against that scheme. Figure 3.1 depicts the report of beneficiaries under the IASRI scholarship scheme. Whereas, in the transaction report, individual organization can view transaction details of a scheme which has been uploaded in the online system in a particular month of a financial year. Figure 3.2 shows the transaction report under the same scheme for the month of February in financial year 2018-19.

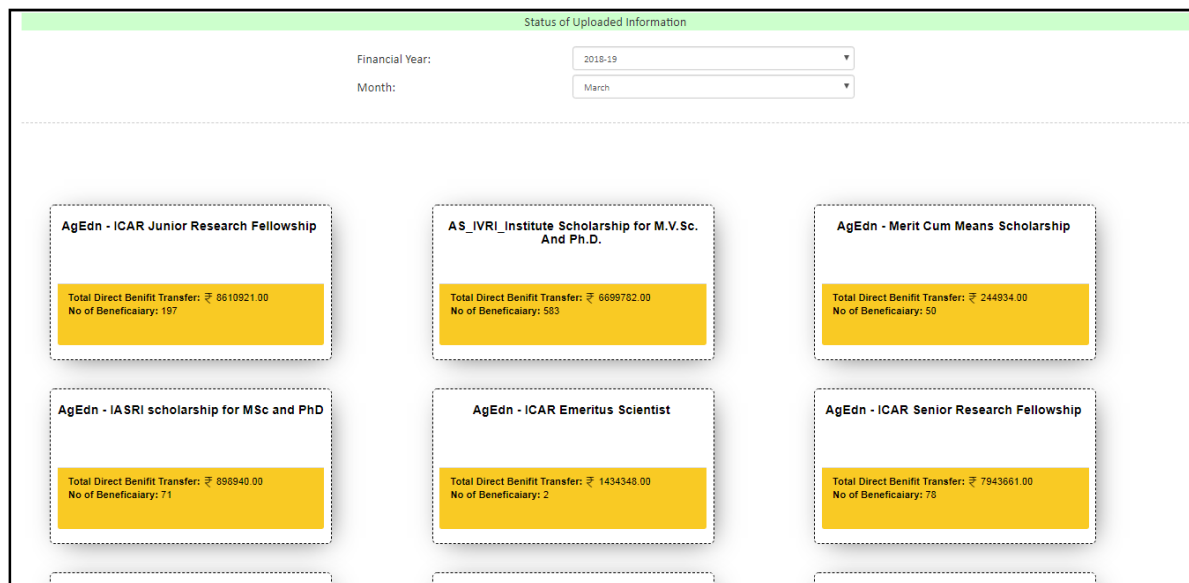


Fig. 3.5: Dashboard for data monitoring

सारांश

इस परियोजना में, एक वेब आधारित प्रबंधन सूचना प्रणाली (एमआईएस) (<https://dbtdare-icar.gov.in>) को डेयर-आईसीएआर की 20 डीबीटी योजनाओं के तहत लाभार्थियों के विवरण और लेनदेन की रिपोर्टिंग के लिए विकसित किया गया है। कुल 20 योजनाओं में से 19 कृषि शिक्षा/अनुसंधान से संबंधित है और एक कृषि विस्तार से संबंधित योजना है। इस योजना को देश भर के विभिन्न आईसीएआर संस्थानों, कृषि विश्वविद्यालयों और कृषि विज्ञान केंद्रों में लागू किया गया है। सभी संस्थानों, जहाँ ये योजनाएँ चल रही हैं, इस एमआईएस में अपना डेटा अपलोड करते हैं। सूचना योजना स्तर पर सममिलित की जाती है और एमआईएस में 20 योजनाओं के लिए मासिक आधार पर 20 मासिक प्रगति रिपोर्ट (एमपीआर) तैयार की जाती हैं। यह ऑनलाइन एप्लिकेशन डॉट नेट फ्रेमवर्क का उपयोग करके और 3-टायर आर्किटेक्चर के आधार पर विकसित किया गया है। इस सिस्टम में लाभार्थियों से संबंधित जानकारी को एक्सेल टेम्पलेट के माध्यम से अपलोड किया जा सकता है। लेनदेन विवरण अपलोड करने के लिए, वेब फॉर्म का उपयोग किया जाता है। यह एमआईएस वर्कफ्लो तरीके से संचालित होता है। एडीजी (इपी एवं एचएस), शिक्षा प्रभाग, आईसीएआर डीबीटी सेल के नोडल ऑफिसर है जो हर महीने योजनाओं से जुड़ी डेटा को अनुमोदन करते हैं। अनुमोदित हो जाने के बाद, इस डेटा को डीबीटी भारत पोर्टल (डीबीटी मिशन ऑफ इंडिया के तहत एक राष्ट्रीय स्तर के पोर्टल) में हर महीने एक निश्चित तिथि पर ले जाया जाता है। दोनों सिस्टम के बीच डेटा विनिमय वेब एप्लिकेशन प्रोग्रामिंग इंटरफेस (वेबएपीआई) के माध्यम से किया जाता है। वर्तमान परिदृश्य में, डेटा को साझा करने के लिए रेस्ट एपीआई का उपयोग किया गया है। एमआईएस में डेटा की निगरानी के लिए संस्थानों और योजना प्रबंधकों दोनों के लिए कई ऑनलाइन रिपोर्ट विकसित की गई हैं। व्यक्तिगत संस्थान एमआईएस में अपने द्वारा अपलोड की गई डेटा देख सकते हैं। योजना प्रबंधक किसी भी समय अपनी संबंधित योजनाओं की डेटा अपलोडिंग स्थिति से संबंधित रिपोर्ट देख सकते हैं। नोडल अधिकारी, डीबीटी सेल, डेयर-आईसीएआर रिपोर्ट और डैशबोर्ड के साथ सभी योजनाओं के लिए डेटा अपलोडिंग स्थिति की निगरानी कर सकते हैं। इस प्रकार, यह एमआईएस समय, ऊर्जा और धन की काफी बचत करेगी और प्रभावी एवं कुशलता पूर्वक जानकारी प्रदान करेगी।

SUMMARY

In this project, a web based Management Information System (MIS) (<https://dbtdare.icar.gov.in>) has been developed for reporting details of beneficiaries and the transactions under 20 DBT applicable schemes of DARE-ICAR. The schemes include student centric schemes i.e. various scholarships and fellowships, faculty schemes and farmer centric schemes. Out of the total 20 schemes, 19 are related to agricultural education/ research wherein the benefit type is cash and in agricultural extension scheme, the benefit type is in kind. The schemes are implemented in various ICAR Institutes, Agricultural Universities and Krishi Vigyan Kendras across the country. All the organizations, where these schemes are running, are facilitated to upload desired information into this MIS. The information is collated at the scheme level and 20 Monthly Progress Reports (MPRs) are generated on monthly basis for the 20 schemes in the system. This online application is developed using .NET framework and 3-tier architecture has been used. In this system, the information related to beneficiaries can be uploaded into the system through excel template. For uploading of transaction details, web forms are used. The system is operated in workflow manner. ADG(EP&HS), Education Division, ICAR is the Nodal Officer, DBT Cell, DARE-ICAR to approve the schemes related information in every month. Once approved, the information is moved to DBT Bharat Portal, a national level portal under DBT Mission of India, on each month in a fixed date. The data exchange between two portals is done through Web Application Programming Interface (WebAPI). In the present system, Representational State Transfer (REST) APIs have been used for sharing of data. A number of online reports have been developed in the MIS both for the individual organizations and the scheme managers for monitoring of the information in the system. Individual organization can view the information already uploaded by it in the MIS. Scheme Managers can view reports related to data uploading status of their respective schemes at any point of time. Nodal Officer, DBT Cell, DARE-ICAR is provided with reports and dashboard through which the real-time monitoring of the data uploading status for all the schemes can be done. Thus, this system will considerably save time, energy and money through transaction costs reduction and acquire the information in a cost effective manner.
