# **RESEARCH HIGHLIGHTS**

- In the bulk evaluation trial at CTRI RS, Jeelugumilli, entries NLSH-1 (low tar hybrid) and JS 117 (low tar line) were found promising with 2,480 and 1,950 kg/ha cured leaf yield, respectively over check variety, Kanchan (CLY 1,950 kg/ha).
- In a replicated trial conducted over two years, two somaclones, NLCM(k) and NLCR-1-11-10 recorded significantly higher (31-26%) cured leaf yields over Kanchan.
- Three test hybrids, Siri x F-212, Siri x Bell-93 and Siri x NC-3150 were significantly superior to the best check variety Siri and other entries in respect of Green leaf, cured leaf, bright leaf yields and grade index at 5% level of significance. Leaf nicotine, reducing sugars and chlorides were in the desirable range.
- Among the three cropping systems tested, greengram – tobacco recorded less infestation of *Orobanche* than sesame- tobacco and sorghum- tobacco.
- B.t.k. can be sprayed in an aqueous solution with E.C. ranging from 0.5 to 6.0 dS/m and pH 7 for effective suppression of *S. litura* in tobacco nursery.
