Mandates

The overall mandate of ICAR-KVK is to develop and disseminate location specific technological modules at district level through Technology assessment, refinement and demonstration and to act as knowledge and resource centre for agriculture and its allied activities. The specific activities to carry out this mandates are:

- Conducting on-farm testing to identify the location specificity of agricultural technologies under various farming systems
- Organizing frontline demonstrations to establish production potential of various crops and enterprises in farmer's fields
- Organizing need based training for farmers to update their knowledge and skills in modern agricultural technologies related to technology assessment, refinement and demonstration, and training of extension personnel to orient them in the frontier areas of technology development
- Creating awareness about improved technologies to larger masses through appropriate extension programmes.
- Production and supply of good quality seeds and planting materials, livestock, poultry and fisheries breeds and products and various bio-products to the farming community.
- Work as resource and knowledge centre of agricultural technology for supporting initiatives of public, private and voluntary sector for improving the agricultural economy of the district.

Director's Message



ICAR-KrishiVigyan Kendra (Ernakulam) of the Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute (CMFRI) is a knowledge and resource centre for agriculture and its allied activities for the whole district. It is quite remarkable that the Ernakulam KVK has developed a strong bondage with the farmers in the district through a slew of extension activities to reach out to them regularly and a series of effective measures for developing adequate facilitates to keep the farming practice on right track. Aimed at promoting safe food production which is the main

thrust area of the KVK, quality organic inputs and seeds are supplied through its Sales Counter located at the CMFRI. In addition, the satellite production centres, established in public-private partnership mode in farmer's fields, produce quality vegetable & fruit planting materials and poultry chicks in large-scale and supply accordingly. Dynamic efforts of the KVK, which are still on since the last five years, in the setting up of many satellite seed production centres of pearl spot with the financial support of the National Fisheries Development Board (NFDB) have been vital to woo youngsters into fish farming. In what is considered as one of the commendable outreach programmes, we could manage to distribute 10,000 curry leaf seedlings to school children as part of 'Karshkamitram' programme conducted by the Vidhyadhanam trust functioning under the patronage of Ernakulam M.P. Prof. K. V. Thomas.

In a major move to resolve the issue faced by the urban farmers in homestead agriculture owing to soil scarcity and the difficulty to set up grow bags, the KVK launched soil-less planting medium based on composted press-mud which received a huge response from farmers as well as entrepreneurs for production and marketing.

Needless to say, marketing their produce has appeared to be a hurdle for the farmers these days. In order to resolve this snag and develop a healthy market atmosphere, the KVK has conceived the idea of farm-gate markets for Pokkali fish and the continuous efforts are underway in successfully facilitating seasonal markets since the last five years. Emulating this model, Pokkali duck could also be marketed in a larger extent this year, helping Pokkali farmers to earn an increased income. Moreover, the Krishi Vigyan Kendra has also formed two farmer producer's companies - Periyar Valley Spices Farmer Producer Company (PVSFPO) and Pokkali Farmer Producer Company (PFPO) with the funding from the NABARD to empower farmers in direct marketing avoiding middlemen.

However, we are of the view that the concerned departments and all agencies functioning in the field of agriculture and allied areas should equally be in touch with the farmers with their valuable contributions in order to improve their living standard. Ernakualam Krishi Vigyan Kendra is always committed for any sorts collaborative initiatives for the benefits of the farmers and it maintains strong linkages with the AMTA and line departments to provide technology backstopping in their programmes.

We also believe that dissemination of information has its own significance in reaching out to the targeted audience timely. This edition of newsletter provides a ringside view of various programmes undertaken by this KVK during the period of 2017-18 with a view to invite fruitful future collaborations from peer institutions, line departments and research organizations and, most importantly, the farmers to work together in the coming years for the betterment of the farming sector in the district.

SOIL-LESS PLANTING MEDIA LAUNCHED

KVK launched planting media devoid of soil during a sales mela conducted at CMFRI, Kochi on 21st September, 2017. The media is composed of composted pressmud; a byproduct from sugar mills, coirpith and powdered cowdung. It also contains neem cake, dolomite and biocontrol agents. The media can be used as an alternative to soil in farming. Approximately 1000 city residents visited the mela and 2000 packets each 10 kg were sold. In addition, KVK received booking for 5000 packets. Approximately 70 potential entrepreneurs approached the Business Desk at the mela expressing their willingness to produce soil-less medium commercially.

SALES MELAS CONDUCTED

Curry leaf-Coriander sales mela was conducted with the objective of propagating safe to eat homestead cultivation of Coriander and Curry leaf as these are the ones that contains maximum pesticide residues. The mela was conducted at CMFRI on 31st August, 2017. About 490 people participated in the mela in which 1100 kits of curry leaf seedlings and coriander seeds were distributed.

Another sales mela cum exhibition of fruit plants conducted at CMFRI on 26th to 28th September, 2017. Around 700 farmers attended and 2200 different fruit tree sapling like Mango, Jack, Jamun, Pomegranate, Guava, Sapota, different Citrus species, Rose apple types, Custard apple, Passion fruit, Cherry etc comprising of good quality graft and layers were distributed in the programme. The exhibition showcased procedure of setting up mini orchards on roof tops.

FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

AGRICULTURE

Application of lime 2 kg/ tree, Micronutrient mixture 250 gm/ tree and farmyard manure 50 kg/tree enhances flowering in Garcinia (Malabar tamarind). Fruit drop can be reduced considerably.

Green challenger is a suitable variety of cabbage for cultivation in rain shelters during June-October period.

Guava trees can be made productive by following semi hard pruning at 2 meter height by retaining 4-5 primary branches. Please ensure 3-4 secondary branches in each primary branch.

Giant African Snails can be effectively controlled using Tobacco decoction and Copper sulphate mixture spray. The snails can be attracted with papaya leaves or cabbage leaves sprayed with toddy.

Good quality Neera can be produced from fishtail palm popularly known as "Kaalippana".

Fruit fly trap is effective against the attack of fruit flies in Bitter gourd. The traps have to be placed in the field at the flowering stage or one month after planting. One fruit fly is sufficient for one cent area.

Application of Dolomite as 2 splits (Basal dressing of 50 percent of recommended dosage and remaining at 30 days after transplanting) and application of borax at 30 days of transplanting increases production in paddy by 16%.

Prophylatic application of pure neem oil extracted from kernels reduces the sucking pest incidence in Solanaceous crops.

Neem cake from kernels is a better organic manure than crushed neem fruit. The former gave 32% more yield in Okra.

FISHERIES

Scientific nursery rearing of fish seeds till fingerling stage is a must follow pre-requisite before releasing to ponds to increase survival percentage.

Karimeen (Pearl spot) seed production is an economically viable venture in brackish water ponds. Ideal size of brackish water pond for commencing such breeding unit is 50 to 100 cent. Pond preparation, weed fish removal, brood stock are the prerequisite steps to commence breeding. Stocking density is 3 pairs per cent area.

Sea fish extract (Aminoplus) is an ideal phytoplankton bloom production/regulator in brackish water fish ponds. Apply sea fish extract 30 ml in one cent area three days after pond preparation and top up in 15 days interval.



ANIMAL HUSBANDRY

Chabro poultry developed by Central Poultry Development Organisation (CPDO), Chandigarh is suitable for growing in homesteads for safe meat production. Its meat has flavour similar to desi poultry.

Broiler duck rearing (9-12 weeks) can be integrated with Pokkali-fish-shrimp culture to augment income of farmers.

It is possible to fabricate Hydroponic unit locally so as to reduce cost. Feeding hydroponic fodder saves pellet feed up to 30%.

SEED PRODUCTION TECHNOLOGY FOR INDIAN POMPANO DEVELOPED

Mariculture activities in India will get a major boost with ICAR-CMFRI successfully developing the seed production technology of Indian pompano (Trachinotus mookalee), which has high commercial value both in domestic and international markets. The institute had earlier developed seed production technology for cobia, silver pompano, orange spotted grouper and pink ear emperor. This is the first report of successful large scale seed production of Indian pompano in the world.

SEA CAGE FARMING OF COBIA UNDER TECHNOLOGY UPGRADATION SCHEME OF NFDB

The training programme on 'Sea-cage Farming of Cobia' under the technology up-gradation scheme of NFDB was successfully organized at Mandapam Regional Centre of ICAR-CMFRI for the fisheries officials of State Fisheries Departments during 13th - 15th November 2017. A total of 18 fisheries officials representing Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh, Kerala and West Bengal Fisheries Departments participated in the training. Hands on training in cage and net fabrication, feed management, growth assessment, net exchange, nursery management, packing & transportation of fish seed, stocking of fingerlings in cages and disease management. Field visit to farming site was also arranged.

MULTIVENDOR E-COMMERCE PLATFORM LAUNCHED

To help fish farmers and fishermen sell their catch directly to the customers, a multi vendor e-commerce website and mobile app has been developed by ICAR-CMFRI under the National Innovations on Climate Resilient Agriculture (NICRA) project. The website "marinefishsales.com" and its mobile app named "marinefishsales" is an interface of multiple vendors and consumers with the

institute as a facilitator, monitoring vendor profiles, order status and sales. It is envisaged as part of improving the income of the small scale fishers and coastal fishermen community whose livelihoods are often affected by Climate Change related processes and help them to get better profits by avoiding middlemen in the market chain.

ICAR-CMFRI PARTNERS WITH ISRO TO FORECAST POTENTIAL FISHING ZONES

The institute has joined hands with the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) to identify and forecast Potential Fishing Zones (PFZ), an area in sea where fishes are seen in abundance. In the first phase, ICAR-CMFRI and the Space Applications Centre (SAC) of the ISRO have jointly launched a research project for identifying, forecasting and monitoring PFZ in coastal and offshore waters of Tamil Nadu. The collaborative project named 'SAMUDRA' is aimed at helping fishermen easily locate shoals of fish without wasting time and fuel. The research work focuses on developing and running a satellite-based ocean forecasting model to provide PFZ advisories.
